



Islamic Society of Greenville Event Guidelines and Liability Waiver

Effective Date: January, 1, 2025

Applicability:

This document applies to all events organized or hosted by the Islamic Society of Greenville, including but not limited to Friday prayers (Jumu'ah Salah), Eid Salah, youth programs, community events, and all activities conducted at the masjid property, including associated premises at the Upstate Islamic Center.

Rules and Guidelines

To maintain a safe, respectful, and organized environment for all attendees, the following rules and expectations are in place:

1. Compliance with Guidelines

All attendees, including minors, are expected to follow the rules and guidelines established by the Executive Committee of the Islamic Society of Greenville. These rules are designed to ensure the safety, comfort, and spiritual well-being of the entire congregation.

2. Authority of Volunteers and Executive Committee

Volunteers and members of the Executive Committee are authorized to enforce these rules. They have the right to intervene and take appropriate action when guidelines are not being followed. This may include, but is not limited to, verbal redirection, temporary removal from specific areas or programs, or requiring a parent/guardian to supervise their child more closely.

3. Supervision of Children

Parents and guardians are responsible for supervising their children at all times. Children who are disruptive, unsafe, or disrespectful may be disciplined appropriately by volunteers or committee members. This does not include physical punishment of any kind, but may include removal from an event, reporting behavior to parents, or restricting access to future programs.



4. Parking Enforcement

In order to ensure emergency access and accessibility for all, unauthorized parking in “No Parking” zones, fire lanes, or handicapped spots without proper permits is strictly prohibited. Parking violation stickers may be placed on vehicles found in violation. Repeat offenses may result in the vehicle being towed at the owner’s expense.

5. Zero Tolerance for Disruptive Behavior

Disruptive behavior, including verbal abuse, disrespect toward staff, or repeated disregard of guidelines may result in removal from the event or temporary banning from the premises, at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

Acknowledgment and Waiver of Liability

By attending any event organized by the Islamic Society of Greenville, you acknowledge and agree to the following:

- You understand and accept that your participation and your child(ren)’s participation in masjid activities is voluntary and at your own risk.
- You waive any and all claims against the Islamic Society of Greenville and its Executive Committee, staff, and volunteers for disciplinary action taken in accordance with the above guidelines.
- You release the Islamic Society of Greenville and its representatives from liability for any consequences resulting from your or your child(ren)’s failure to adhere to the guidelines.
