The ISG may allow Vendors (businesses/individuals) to sell certain items at its premises at times. This is purely to benefit the Muslim community & the Muslim vendors. To ensure safety & proper functioning of the regular affairs of the ISG &/or due to other reasons, the ISG reserves the right to refuse any vendor to sell items at its premises. A vendor can seek permission for sale by filing this form at least two weeks prior to the day of sale. He/she is expected to follow the guidelines listed below & others as communicated by the ISG from time to time. Please provide copy of your Driver License.

- The vendor must be a Muslim.
- The items sold are mostly restricted to Halal food & Islamic Clothing. Sales of literature & media such as books, DVDs, etc. in general are not allowed.
- No selling is allowed during the Khutbah & Salah (Prayer).
- Once a vendor is approved, any Friday they want to sell, they should check with ISG on Monday of that week. This ensures there is no conflict with any other activities. ISG will try to accommodate all vendors in a reasonable fashion & expect vendors to follow the instructions without arguing.
- By default, ISG related activities take top priority. So, for ISG events such as bake sale, no other food vendors will be allowed on that day. If anyone does show up, they will be asked to leave.
- ISG is not required to provide any furniture, &/or other items to vendors. ISG, based on their discretion & availability of such items, might allow vendors with prior approval to use these items temporarily for vending. In such cases they are expected to clean & put them back in proper place.
- Vendors will be responsible for taking care of the space they utilize, including cleaning.
- Vendors are solely responsible for the items they sell.
- All food must be prepared & handled in accordance with local health regulations. By signing this document, vendors acknowledge sole responsibility for it & ISG is free of any liability whatsoever. Each food vendor should provide proof for food safety training, ISG could help if needed.
- Vendor(s) may be required to relocate or even leave the site based on any emergency situation/ circumstances disturbing normal operation of ISG, which are of higher priority.
- ISG highly recommend vendors to give 10% of proceeds (based on trust) as donation to ISG, as ISG maintains facilities in the long run.
- Every vendor is expected to follow these & other guidelines. Refusal to do so could result in vendor removal &/or being banned from selling for a minimum of six (6) months.
